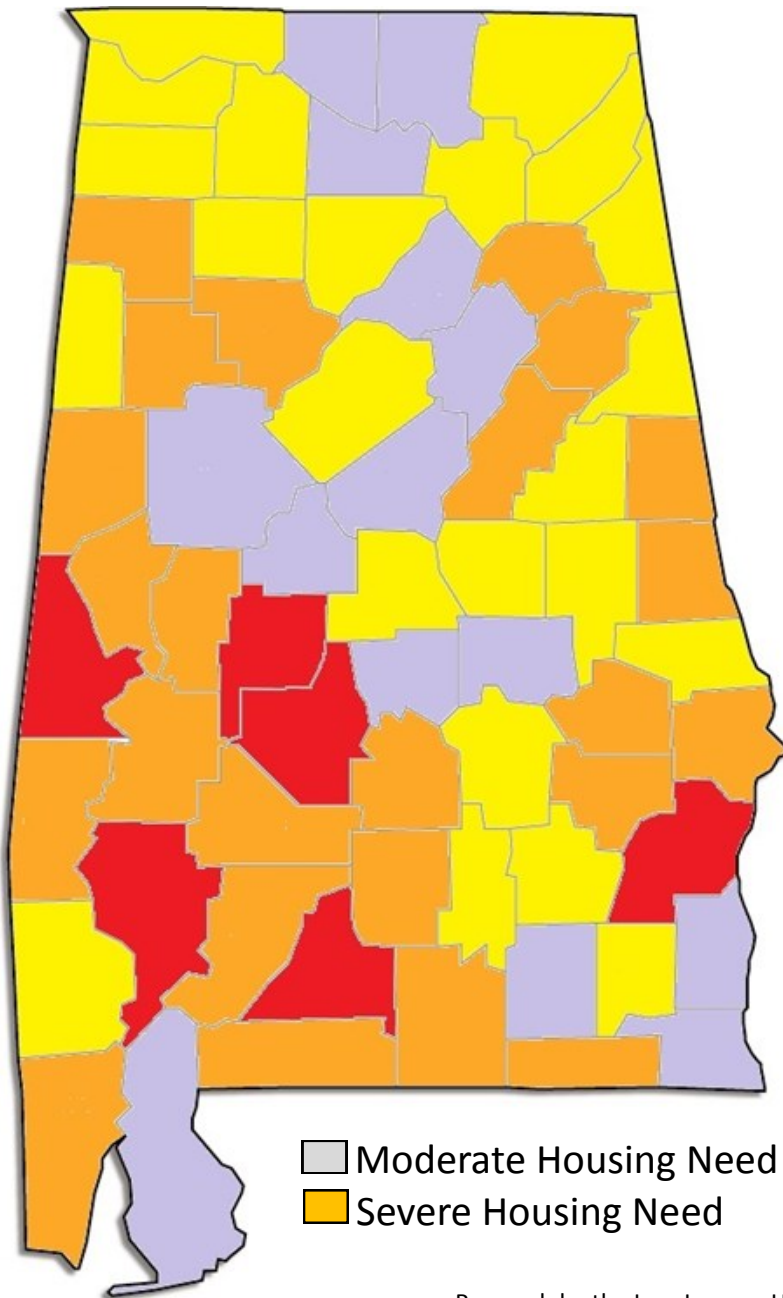
Nearly 7 out of 10 Alabamians see our lack of affordability as a problem.
